What Is Mom Prom?

A "Mom Prom" is a massive girls' night out – a chance for women 21 and older to get together and dance, eat, drink, talk, laugh, pose for pictures with their friends, relive some of their own glory days, and make new memories. It's also a fun way to support an important cause because all funds raised support the mission of Family & Children's Services to inspire hope and well-being by removing barriers to accessing mental health treatment.

What Is Family & Children's Services?

Founded in 1925, Family & Children's Services of Mid-Michigan (FCS) is a private, non-profit, non-sectarian, multi service agency. Our mission is to inspire hope and well-being for people of all ages by providing counseling, education and support. Since its inception, FCS has continued to develop new programs and initiatives to meet needs identified in the community. We are unique in that we turn no one away regardless of presenting concern or ability to pay.

Public health experts are predicting a tsunami of coming mental health needs due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In a survey conducted by the Centers for Disease Control last June, nearly half of American adults reported that their mental health had been negatively affected by the COVID-19 pandemic and 11% had seriously considered suicide in the last 30 days. Many people in our region are also still coping with the devastation of the flood caused by the failure of two dams last summer.

FCS is the call for help made by over 1,000 people each year. The majority of those we serve have always been of low to moderate income and over 40% of our clients report incomes of under \$20,000 per year. We are unique in that we turn no one away, regardless of age, presenting concern, ability to pay, or any other factor. We offer many free programs, including crisis services, counseling to youth in their schools during the school day, a summer day camp for teens involved in the juvenile justice and community mental health systems. Paid counseling services are offered on a sliding fee scale so that those with the lowest income pay the lowest fees. Client scholarships are also available, as deductibles and co-pays can be barriers to accessing care even for those who do have insurance.

Early intervention for mental health problems can prevent or lessen behaviors and experiences that can have long-term negative consequences not only on the individuals themselves, but also impact the entire community including unemployment, homelessness, involvement in the criminal justice system, substance abuse, self-harm, and even suicide.

Only 41 percent of Michiganders with mental health problems received treatment last year. Your support can help to change those numbers by making sure that those who need treatment are able to receive it Mom Prom is at its simplest an event to help moms and families and we would be grateful for your support!
